Spring & Fall 4-Day Science Camps: Learn about and camp at Lake Tahoe, hike in the forest, do astronomy, geology, ecology, nature writing, and team building. Meals, heated lodging (with tipis for larger groups), activity guides, field journals, and instructional staff are all included. *\$225 per student*

Winter 2 & 3-Day Programs: Snowshoe and learn winter safety, snow science, winter adaptations, and astronomy. Stay in cozy heated cabins on the shore of Lake Tahoe. Meals, teaching staff, and snowshoes provided. Warm clothing can be lent as needed. *\$150 per student for three days and \$100 for two days*

Day Trips: Hike in the forest, learn local species and issues, net aquatic invertebrates. Snowshoe to learn about our Sierra snowpack and winter ecology. *Costs vary with trip length and location. Usually \$15*

NOTE: Some discounts may be available depending upon community support and are allocated based on percentage of children qualifying for free and reduced meals.

20% deposit reserves your session. Your deposit is due within 45 days of receipt of this registration form, or your preferred session may be advertised to other schools.

Deposits are needed at least six months before your scheduled program season to guarantee camp availability. Refundable until March 1 for fall programs, Oct. 1 for winter programs, and Nov. 1 for spring programs. We are prepared to adapt to weather conditions and only expect to re-schedule or cancel due to road closures.

Payment: Balance is due during first day of program. A final invoice will be provided.

Guaranteed Minimum = Your school pays fees for the guaranteed minimum of 80% of the students expected to attend, even if the number actually attending drops below that level. We may deny student numbers above the anticipated number because of program site limitations.
