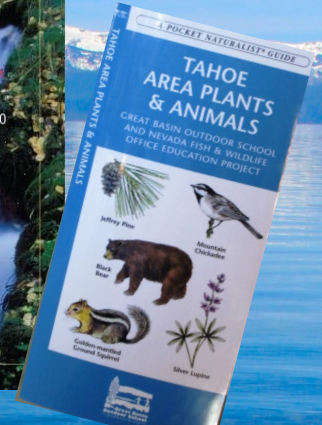
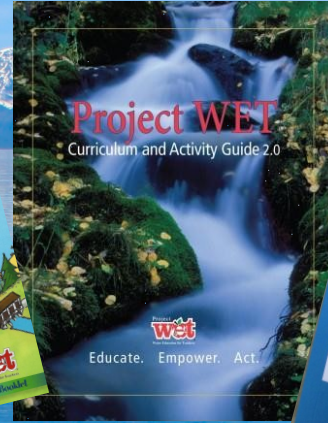
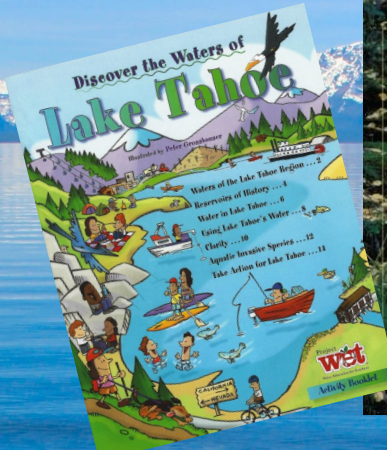

Reminders & Driving Directions:

Wear: We'll be learning in our great Tahoe outdoors all day, so wear comfy outdoor layers, sunscreen, and a hat or visor for the sun. Closed-toe shoes are safest for our forest and pond explorations, and you may want something like Tevas for our beach time. Be ready to go from cool to hot and back again.

Bring: Water in refillable water bottle. We try to be "green" and discourage using bottled water. Bring your sack lunch, extra sunscreen, an extra layer to wear, & a pen or pencil, all ideally in a little daypack.

Driving Directions: Please allow time to arrive by 9:00 AM ready to start at Spooner Lake in the Lake Tahoe Nevada State Park. Spoooner Lake (Red Star on the map) is located on Highway 28 one half mile north of Highway 50 on the Nevada side of Lake Tahoe. From Carson City it is 10 miles to the west off Hwy 50; from Incline Village it is 10 miles south; from the Stateline casinos it is 12 miles north.



Camp Galilee where we will spend the afternoon on the shore of Lake Tahoe is on Highway 50 four miles south of Spooner Lake & a half mile south of Glenbrook across from the post office. Leaving Spooner Lake, turn left onto Highway 28 and stay to the right to get onto Hwy 50 heading toward South Lake Tahoe. Pass Glenbrook and watch for the **fire station with the red roof** on your left and the **blue post office sign** and the **green Galilee sign** on your right. Turn right toward the lake into the Galilee driveway after passing the green Galilee sign. Parking is limited at Camp Galilee, so carpooling is appreciated. Park beside the church or the circle driveway.
